All gifts must be authorized by the Secretary-Treasurer or designate (President).

- b) In cases of illness or injury where a member is hospitalized or in cases where his/her absence is of ten working days or more, fruit, flowers, reading material, or some other appropriate gift may be sent.
- c) In cases of extended absence, the procedures in 5 (a)/(b) may be repeated at the discretion of the Secretary-Treasurer, but not before the member has been absent from the job for 30 working days or more.
